Since its creation I've first been in charge of the start up of the operative body of the Foundation for the International Prevention of Genocide and Mass Atrocities and later of the shaping of its policies and objectives and in developing its relations with International Organizations, States and other INGOs dedicated to the prevention of mass atrocities and the protection of human rights.

I'm acting as Director of the Research and Cooperation Programme.

At the Budapest Centre the duty of the Director is to be a catalyst for relevant information and early warning coming from various sources, and operating an integrated warning-response support system which formulates policy recommendations and generates political consensus for early action at international and regional level.

As Director of Research I daily provide analysis, recommendations, methodology and support on mediation efforts in situations of instability that could lead to mass atrocities, as well as try to centralize and improve the quality of information, map existing competence in the field of genocide prevention, connecting academics and experts.

As Director of Cooperation I also facilitate meetings and workshops aimed at enhancing cooperation among stakeholders, actors, donors, NGOs and representatives of media at regional level where the concrete tasks and challenges could be set on the agenda from the perspectives of genocide and mass atrocities.
